Suwon Indoor Badminton Court, Jeonju, South Korea

Present: 14 representatives of Asian countries/territories and 1 representative of IGF

1. Discussions

- To form AGF officially
- Six directors were selected: India, Malaysia, Mongolia, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam
- Japan and China will be Directors upon participation in AGF
- AGF office will send the revised Statue of AGF regarding change of number of directors from 6 to 7 to member countries via e-mail
- AGF office will require member countries necessary approval to register AGF as a legal body
- Kun-ho Cho the President of AGF/KBF will visit Japan and China around Nov. or Dec. 2007 to discuss inclusion of Japan and China to AGF
- Kun-ho Cho the President of AGF/KBF strongly expressed his opinion

that chairmanship shall be rotated every two years. Ideal rotation scheme is that Japan and China will be a President Nation for two years or vice versa. After this rotation, host country of Asian Olympic Game will automatically be the president nation. House approved the same
